

Decorating the Barn



Purley on Thames Parish Council (PC) appreciates that making a celebration special can mean using decorations to create the perfect atmosphere. It is delighted that hirers are using the barn for their very special occasions and ask that the following guidelines be followed to ensure the fabric of the building is protected so many more special occasions and memories can be created at Purley barn.

Decoration guidelines

- Decorations can be hung over or tied around the beams in the barn.
- Fairy lights and battery powered tea lights can be used.
- Existing hooks and nails in the old beams can be used to hang items.
- Please use the trolleys to move the tables around the hall, otherwise the floor is scratched by dragging tables and the overall appearance of the hall will suffer.

If decorations are required at height, then our caretaker will hang them on your behalf but these will necessarily need to be limited.

I'm afraid we cannot permit:

- The use of drawing pins, nails and blue-tack on the walls of the barn.
- Candles, tea-lights or any other naked flame.
- Placing heavy items on top of the store cupboards.
- Placing items within a meter of the heaters - *when they are on!*
