



PURLEY ON THAMES BURIAL GROUND

SCHEDULE OF BURIAL FEES

(from 1 August 2018)

Part 1 – Interments

This is a fee for the placement of a body or cremated remains within the burial ground

	Resident	Non-Resident
The body of a child either still born or which had not reached the age of twelve years at the time of death	£90	£900
The body of a person whose age at death exceeded twelve years	£145	£1,450
The cremated remains of a person of any age	£105	£1,050

Part 2 – Exclusive Rights of Burial in an earthen grave

This is a fee for the lease of an interment plot for a period of seventy-five years, at the expiry of which term; the holders shall have a right to renew for a further period at the fees pertaining at that time.

	Resident	Non-Resident
A grave 2.7 metres by 1.2 metres (capable of accommodating two bodies)	£395	£3,950
A place for cremated remains 550 mm x 550 mm	£130	£1,300

Note that this fee includes the legal and associated fees for the Deed of Grant

Part 3 – re-opening of existing grave

Where an interment is to take place within an existing grave for which an exclusive right of burial exists then the following fees shall apply.

	Resident	Non-Resident
To re-open an existing grave	£160	£1,600
To re-open an existing place for cremated remains	£100	£1,000
To create a place for cremated remains within an existing grave (this constitutes the second interment in the plot)	£100	£1,000

Part 4 – Memorials and Inscriptions

This fee confers the right to erect or place a memorial or other object at the site of an interment

	Resident	Non-Resident
A headstone with inscription	£85	£850
A vase with or without inscription	£25	£250
A cremation memorial stone with inscription	£50	£500
For each inscription at a subsequent date	£15	£150

Definitions

Resident For those who have lived in the Civil Parish of Purley on Thames or the Ecclesiastical Parish of Purley in the ten years prior to decease.

Non-resident Anyone not eligible for the resident rate.

Search Fees

These fees are set by virtue of the Burials Act 1953. They cover the cost of searching for an entry in the Burial Register.

These fees are obtainable on application to the Parish Clerk.

General Rules

Note that this document refers only to the fees to be charged for use of the Burial Ground. The rules of the Burial Ground must be complied with. These fees may be reviewed annually.
