P23/131-1 To agree that any withdrawal or transfer of funds deposited in any investment account other than the Parish Council's main bank accounts (currently with Lloyds Bank) is to be authorised by a resolution at the Finance & Governance Committee Meeting and/or a full Council Meeting authorising that withdrawal or transfer of funds.

- P23/131- 2 To require the Chairman of Council to conduct an annual review of the performance of the Clerk and keep a written record of it as required by Standing Order 19 [c].
- P23/131-3 To approve and adopt the draft Financial Risk Assessment dated 5 October 2023 as circulated.

- P23/131-4 To proceed to invite bids through contract finder to carry out the required improvements to the water main and supply for the Goosecroft site.
- P23/131-5 To proceed with the proposed application for members bid funding as approved on 13 June 2023 by Council (Resolution P23/89-7). New information has come to light now that the decision has been confirmed by West Berkshire Council to run the scheme this year with a closing date of 31 October 2023, and with a requirement of match funding from the applicants.
